REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING
TUESDAY, OCTOBER 10, 2017 7:30 PM**

Gail Rueff opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mark Wolter made a motion, seconded by Steve Doerflinger to approve the minutes of the September 12, 2017 regular board meeting and the September 12, 2017 Budget Adoption Meeting. Motion carried 5-0. Voting in favor: Gail Rueff, Mark Wolter, Steve Doerflinger, Shannon McLeod and David Springmeyer.
