REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING
TUESDAY, JUNE 11, 2019 7:30 PM

Those present were: Mark Wolter, Shannon McLeod, Amy Wickens, Steve Doerflinger, Jeff Dougan, and David Springmeyer. Also present were: Tom Hunter, Cindy Navarra, Tammy Williams, Vicki Houk and Joshua Heath with Greensburg Daily News.

Mark Wolter opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Amy Wickens made a motion, seconded by Steve Doerflinger to approve the minutes of the May 14, 2019 regular board meeting. Motion carried 5-0. Voting in favor: Mark Wolter, Amy Wickens, Steve Doerflinger, Jeff Dougan, and David Springmeyer. Shannon McLeod abstained from voting.
