REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING
TUESDAY, JUNE 12, 2018 7:30 PM

Those present were: Mark Wolter, Steve Doerflinger, Jeff Dougan and David Springmeyer. Also present were: Tom Hunter, Tammy Williams and Vicki Houk.

Mark Wolter opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from the May 8, 2018 school board meeting have been tabled to the July 10, 2018 meeting.
