

**GREENSBURG COMMUNITY SCHOOLS**  
**REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING**  
**TUESDAY, JULY 10, 2018 7:30 PM**

Those present were: Gail Rueff, Mark Wolter, Steve Doerflinger, Amy Wickens and David Springmeyer. Also present were: Tom Hunter, Cindy Navarra, Vicki Houk and Joshua Heath with Greensburg Daily News.

Gail Rueff opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Steve Doerflinger made a motion, seconded by Amy Wickens to approve the minutes of the May 8, 2018 school board meeting. Motion carried 5-0. Voting in favor: Gail Rueff, Mark Wolter, Steve Doerflinger, Amy Wickens and David Springmeyer. The minutes from the June 12, 2018 school board meeting have been tabled to the August 14, 2018 meeting.

Mark Wolter made a motion, seconded by David Springmeyer to approve vouchers 26802-26999. Motion carried 5-0. Voting in favor: Gail Rueff, Mark Wolter, Steve Doerflinger, Amy Wickens and David Springmeyer.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

Mr. Hunter reported on the fund balances. Amy Wickens made a motion, seconded by Steve Doerflinger to approve the financial report as presented. Motion carried 5-0. Voting in favor: Gail Rueff, Mark Wolter, Steve Doerflinger, Amy Wickens and David Springmeyer.

Mr. Hunter thanked Cindy Navarra for the numerous hours she has been putting in working on the new budget, getting our system ready for the transition from six funds to two funds. A meeting will be scheduled in August with the DLGF.

David Springmeyer made a motion, seconded by Mark Wolter to approve the Agreement and Program Incentives between Decatur County Memorial Hospital and Greensburg Community Schools as presented. Motion carried 4-0. Voting in favor: Gail Rueff, Mark Wolter, Steve Doerflinger and David Springmeyer. Amy Wickens abstained from voting. (See Attachment A).

Steve Doerflinger made a motion, seconded by Amy Wickens to appoint Cindy Navarra as Corporation Treasurer and Andrea Phillips as Deputy Treasurer for Greensburg Community Schools. Motion carried 5-0. Voting in favor: Gail Rueff, Mark Wolter, Steve Doerflinger, Amy Wickens and David Springmeyer.

Mr. Hunter asked for board members to serve with him on a committee to establish the District Goals for 2018-2019. Gail Rueff, Amy Wickens and Mark Wolter will all serve on the committee, a meeting will be scheduled for early August to meet.

Amy Wickens made a motion, seconded by David Springmeyer to approve "Resolution to Transfer General Fund Monies to the Prepaid Lunch Fund". Motion carried 5-0. Voting in favor: Gail Rueff, Mark Wolter, Steve Doerflinger, Amy Wickens and David Springmeyer.

David Springmeyer made a motion, seconded by Mark Wolter to approve “Resolution to Establish an Education Fund and Operations Fund”. Motion carried 5-0. Voting in favor: Gail Rueff, Mark Wolter, Steve Doerflinger, Amy Wickens and David Springmeyer.

Mark Wolter made a motion, seconded by Amy Wickens to approve “Resolution giving Superintendent Hunter the authority to sign official legal documents on behalf of the Greensburg Board of Trustees”. Motion carried 5-0. Voting in favor: Gail Rueff, Mark Wolter, Steve Doerflinger, Amy Wickens and David Springmeyer.

Mr. Hunter presented board members with the following NEOLA policy updates. Steve Doerflinger made a motion, seconded by David Springmeyer to approve the policies as presented. Motion carried 5-0.
