REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

Jeff Dougan opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Tammy Williams updated board members on curriculum and instruction. We are currently in the processing of moving away from Acuity Testing and moving towards NWEA, will be taking 40 staff members for face to face training.

Sue Auffenberg, GHS Guidance Director, presented data on the Dual Credits, Diplomas, and AP Successes with Greensburg Community High School students. (See Attachment B). 67% of graduating students earned dual credits. 80% of students earned Honors/Core 40 Diplomas. 85% of students Post-Secondary Plans are going onto some type of trade school, 2 to 4 year College or Military. September 1, 2016, scheduling for 2017-2018 school year will begin. Ms. Auffenberg was thanked for all her hard work and getting the best for our students.

Mr. Clifford, GJHS Principal, explained the procedure used to identify students eligible for the enrichment classes at the Jr. High School. (See Attachment C).
