Jeff Dougan opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

- Interviews are scheduled with candidates for the Greensburg Jr. High School Assistant Principal position on May 15 & May 16, 2017. Steve Doerflinger, Board Member has agreed to serve on the interviewing committee.
- Tammy Williams updated the board on the Archery Teams. Congratulations to all three teams. The Nationals will be held in Louisville, KY next week. GES had 60 students try out for the team, 24 were chosen. They won the county bucket this year, Megan Moore,

first year coaching the team, is very proud of her team. GJHS has 15 archers on the team, they had finished with a 2nd place, a 3rd place, and 5 of the archers had a perfect score. GHS has 16 archers, 14 will be going to Nationals next week. 8 of their archers, qualified as Academic Archers, plus 3 senior archers were awarded scholarships. We are very proud of all our Archery Teams.

- Grant Peters, High School Principal, was pleased to report that GCHS has been endorsed as an Early College High School through the Center of Excellence in Leadership of Learning. He congratulated both Ms. Sue Auffman and Ms. Caroline Keel, Guidance Counselors. The dual credits began during the 2006-2007 school year, going from earning 219 college credits to last school year earning 2, 270 dual credits.
- Matt Clifford, Jr. High Principal wanted to congratulate “Leaders in Literature”. Five of Mr. Matt Slaven’s students were honored for writing excellence.
