David Springmeyer opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

David Weigel made a motion, seconded by Steve Doerflinger to approve the minutes of April 14, 2015 regular school board meeting. Motion carried 5-0. Voting in favor: David Springmeyer, Steve Doerflinger, Al Moore, David Weigel and Gail Rueff.
